

ALLERGY AWARENESS POLICY

- Any allergies/ special requirements are included in our registration form.
- It is the parents/ carers responsibility to ensure that the setting has all current information, regarding any child's allergy/ tolerance or illness. This must include trigger factors, severity, official medical confirmation and medication/ actions required.
- All parental forms/ contracts containing allergy information are reviewed at least once a year or sooner if additional information needs to be added.
- Parent inform us of any other advice given by other professionals e.g. hospital check-ups.
- All staff have access to allergy awareness training and every room member holds a First Aid Certificate.
- Parents will be asked to sign Emergency Medical Treatment consent on their registration forms.
- Children's special requirements will be displayed within the relevant rooms including the kitchen area to ensure all staff are aware of the child's individual requirements.
- The cook will be informed immediately of the child's requirements to ensure compliance throughout the setting.
